Position Summary:

Seasonal, full-time position lasting four (4) months.

Perform a variety of grounds maintenance work for the Walla Walla Regional Airport & Industrial Park and other Port locations throughout the city; maintain lawns, edge, pull weeds, weed-eat, prune shrubs, irrigate, spray, place rock and cut and haul debris; clean and perform minor maintenance of buildings.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be 16 years of age by date of hire.
- Valid Washington driver's license and good driving record.
- Ability to pass a FBI background security check and drug test.
- Some experience in maintaining grounds and facilities, farm and/or harvest labor acceptable.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Observe applicable security and safety rules, regulations and procedures. Safety is job one!
- Perform a variety of grounds keeping duties including mowing, raking, weeding, trimming, cutting shrubs, edging landscaped areas using weed eaters.
- Perform landscaping and beautification activities; maintain flower beds, shrubbery, pull weeds and ensure proper irrigation.
- Assist in the installation, repair, replacement and service to irrigation systems; inspect functioning of sprinklers and report malfunctioning sprinkler systems to appropriate personnel.
- Pick up litter and empty trash receptacles.
- Perform minor and preventative maintenance and repair work on equipment and facilities; assist with related maintenance work.
